



Visiting Researchers Program at CFR

This program aims to encourage the presence of internationally renowned scientists from outside Quebec at CFR. Financial support will be provided to cover the costs associated with their travel, accommodation, and travel within Quebec (i.e., between CFR poles). This incentive measure will stimulate collaborations between the international scientific community and CFR members in its research programming. It will also promote repeated interactions between our students and invited individuals whose expertise is likely to serve as a model of research excellence. CFR has an annual budget of \$10,000 for this program.

How to apply:

The invited person must come from **outside Quebec** and be on an official visit to the laboratories of a regular CFR member **for a period of at least 1 month**.

The invited scientific person must have a status equivalent to that of a **university professor** or **government researcher** (and maintain the employment relationship with their employer) and come to CFR to contribute to teaching and research activities with other CFR members.

An official application to the CFR Executive Committee must be submitted, indicating the name and origin of the invited scientific person, the reasons for their visit, arrival and departure dates, and the amount requested from CFR (up to \$2,000/month for a maximum of \$6,000).

A detailed schedule of planned research and representation activities showing tangible connections with CFR members in the host university, as well as in the other constituent poles (Montreal, East, Abitibi-Temiscamingue, and Sherbrooke) of CFR.

Requests will be evaluated based on (1) the structuring effect for CFR, (2) the proposed program by the visiting person, and (3) the duration of the stay.

The request must be submitted by a regular member of the CFR.

For stays planned in 2023-2024, submit your application to Luc Lauzon (lauzon.luc@uqam.ca) until **December 20, 2023**.

Note: Only one application per fiscal year is allowed for this program. The committee will favor requests from different poles, universities, or regions.
